**Blended learning concept**  
Health[e]Foundation offers several blended learning programs with different areas of focus, such as HIV/AIDS, pediatric HIV, and tuberculosis. Each program consists of a three month training period followed by certification, electronic updates and continuous education. The training period includes a kickoff meeting, an e-learning course available online and offline (on a USB memory stick), and a closing workshop. Participants are encouraged to interact with peers and to seek e-tutor support via their personalized e-learning account, the participant portal. Health[e]Foundation guarantees continuous medical education for all participants following completion of the training course through annual updates of course content, as well as access to new modules and programs.
